- Review and comment on alternative plans for transportation improvements plans;
- Review forecasts of funding for transportation improvements;
- Offer and discuss suggestions for addressing areas of concern involving roadway safety, access and congestion, transit service, bicycle and pedestrian facilities, and freight movement;
- Discuss transportation issues with representatives with the local governments, VDOT, and the consultant team; and,
- Sign up to receive information as the plan update process moves toward completion.

Citizens will be encouraged to express their comments and concerns as the development of the Long Range Transportation Plan continues. While this is the second Citizens Information Meeting, additional opportunities for citizen review and comment will be provided in the future.
