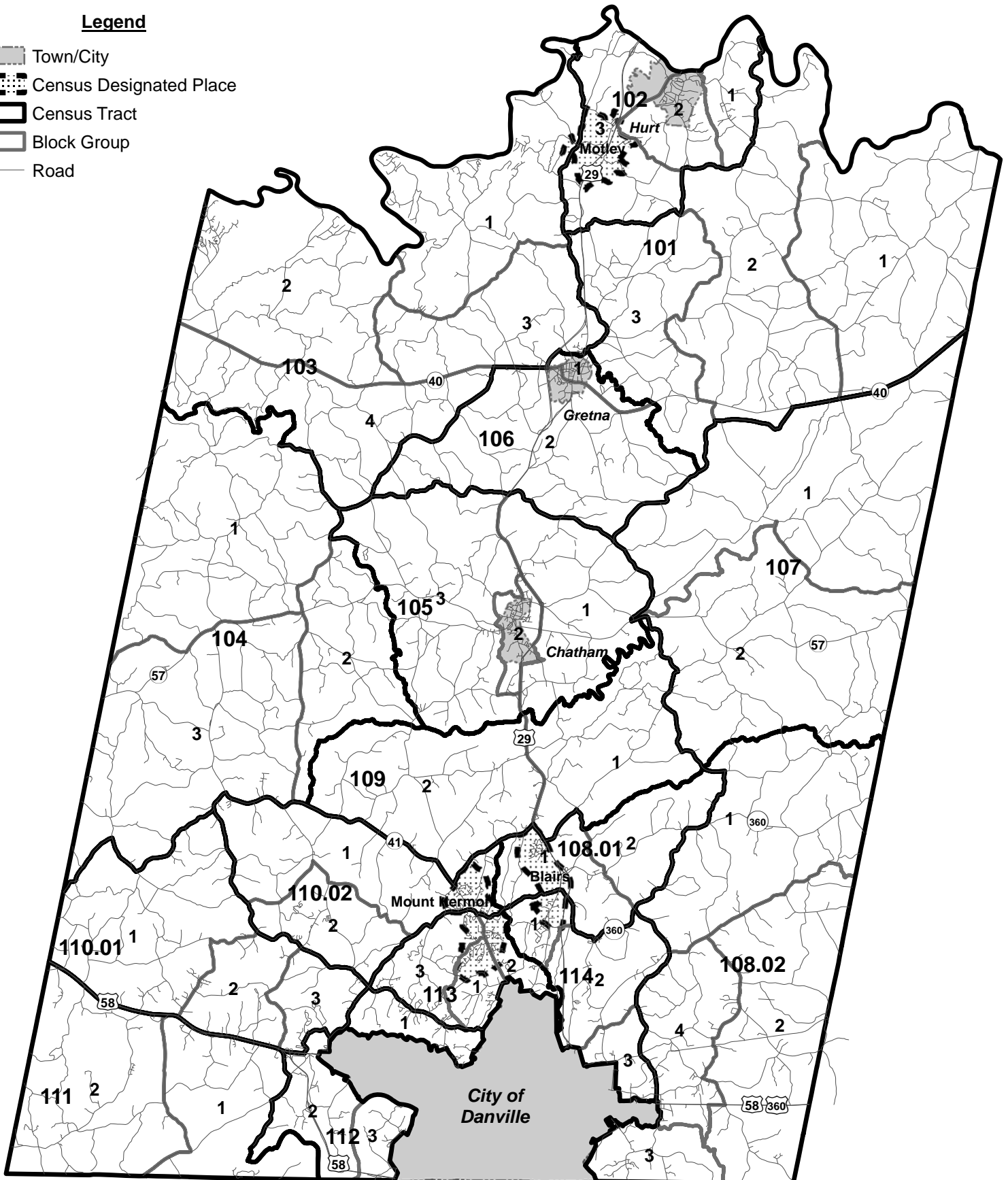


# Pittsylvania County 2010 Census Geography with Roads



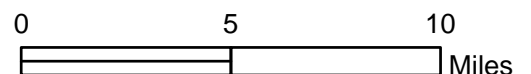
