



















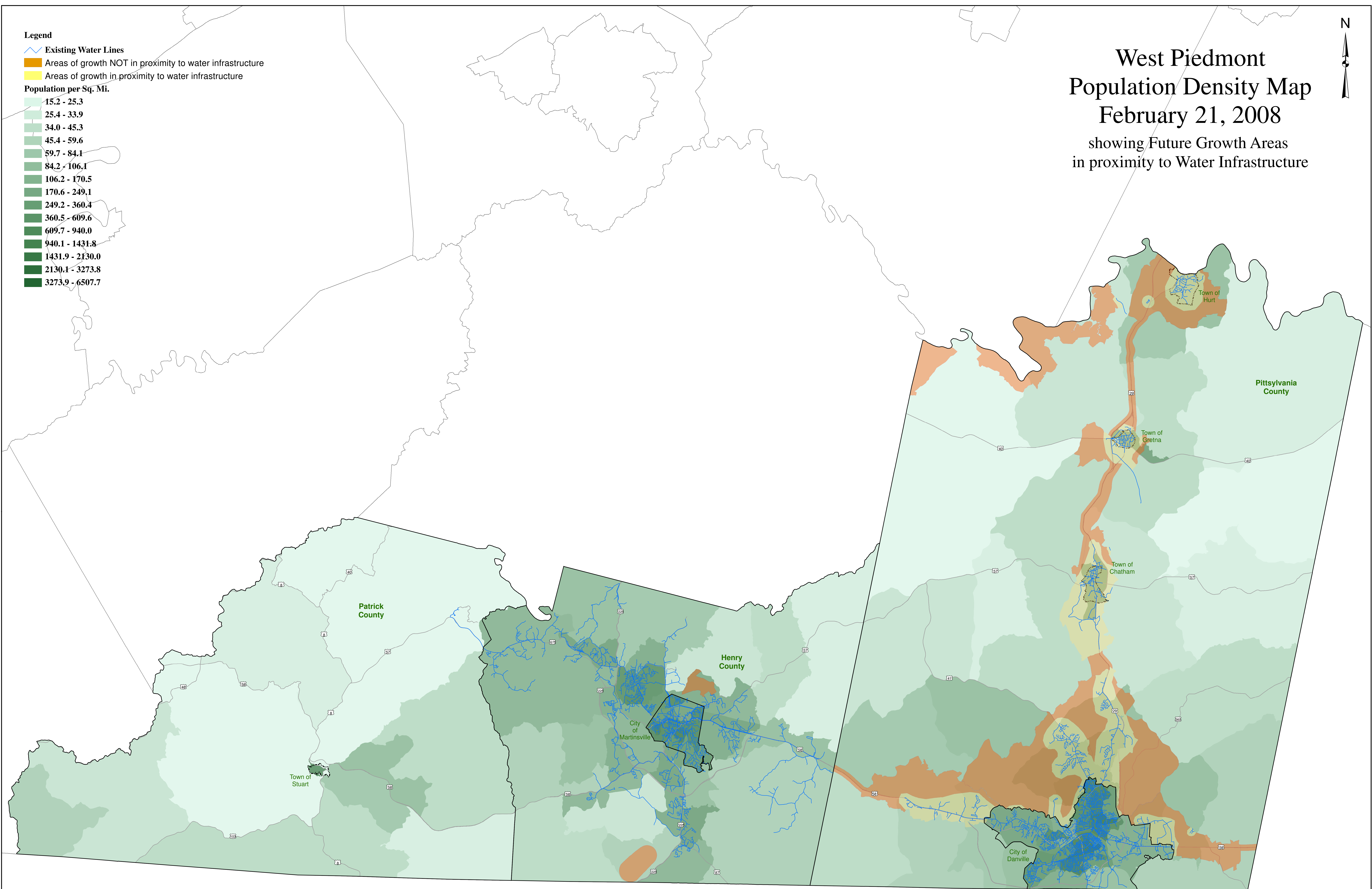


West Piedmont Population Density Map
